Minutes for Coventry Steering Committee meeting of December 28th, Town Hall, Conf. Room B

1. Called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Pope. In attendance were members Tom Pope, Julie Blanchard. Absent were Richard Williams and Lisa Thomas. Also in attendance was John Elsesser.
2. Minutes accepted as submitted on a motion by Julie Blanchard, seconded by Tom Pope and unanimously adopted.
3. A. Chairman Report – Topic of Altering or changing size or terms of Board and Commission discussed briefly. Mr. Elsesser explained that it depends on how the commission or committee was created. If by ordinance a public hearing is required. If by Council charge a simple vote by Council is sufficient.
B. The Chair discussed the vacancies on Cable Advisory Committee #314. It was clarified who the appointing authority is
4. No Action since there were no resignations or non interest statements for reappointments received.


7. After a brief discussion and clarification of the Town Attorney's tweak of the proposed ordinance on prohibiting appointment and simultaneous service on Land Use Boards and Commissions Julie Blanchard moved and Tom Pope seconded to send this proposal to the Town Council for consideration and possible calling of a Public Hearing. (See Attached) Unanimously approved.

8. Tom Pope passed out a draft of a possible ordinance to freeze tax increases on seniors over the age of 65 who have resided in town for a minimum of 30 years and meeting certain other requirements (See attached). There was discussion on the draft and how to calculate the fiscal impact of the proposal but it was felt to be minor due to the length of residency and other requirements. Mr. Elsesser offered to seek help from the planning staff of CRCOG to develop an estimate of the number of qualifying households. Julie Blanchard moved to suggest that the Finance Committee also review for fiscal impact, seconded by Tom Pope and unanimously approved.

9. Mrs. Blanchard and Mr. Pope were pleased to see the commendation of Joe Callahan and Mr. Pope stated he would mention under his report at Council.

10. On a Motion by Julie Blanchard, Seconded by Tom Pope the Meeting was unanimously adjourned at 8:46 PM

Existing Ordinance

DUAL CHAIRMANSHIP ORDINANCE

No person shall be elected or appointed to the chairmanship of more than one standing municipal office, board, committee, agency, authority or commission. Should an individual be elected to chair a second municipal office, board, committee, agency, authority or commission, such individual must resign one chairmanship prior to the next meeting of said body. The Town Council may remove any individual from a chairmanship for failure to comply with this requirement.

Notwithstanding, this Ordinance shall not apply to the Chair of the Town Council who may also chair any municipal office, board, committee, agency, authority or commission which authority vests in the Town Council.

Proposed Ordinance – subject to review and revision by the Town Attorney

SIMULTANEOUS MEMBERSHIP ORDINANCE

No person shall be elected or appointed to serve simultaneously on the Planning and Zoning Commission, Inland Wetlands (Agency) Commission and/or the Zoning Board of Appeals. Should an individual be elected to serve a second position, such individual must resign from one position prior to the next meeting of said body. If any individual shall fail to comply with this requirement, the Town Council shall remove such individual from the position to which said individual was most recently appointed or elected.

Senior Tax Option Plan (CONCEPTIAL DRAFT ONLY)

The Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.) provide guidelines for municipally-funded elderly tax relief. Local options for elderly tax relief are not mandated by the state, however the state provides minimum criteria for applicants to qualify for the programs as well as guidelines for implementation.

Coventry as a community recognizes the importance and significance of the long term contributions our past generations have made to establish and build the quality of life we enjoy today as citizens of this great community. It was through their vision, hopes, dreams, and hard work that Coventry has become the Town we enjoy and call home today.

It is in tribute and appreciation to them that we recognize their contribution and establish a Senior Tax Option Plan (**STOP**) hereafter referred to as **STOP**. A plan for citizens above the age of 65 that have been long-term residents and currently have limited resources to continue to support increased government taxation.

STOP will allow a citizen to freeze their residential property tax at current levels, **STOP** is for citizens that qualify, based on past contribution and continued length of residence. **STOP** will provide assurance for citizens with limited funds to have some protection from government taxation increases that would erode or eliminate what income qualifying citizens do receive.

To qualify for **STOP** a person or couple must meet the following qualifications:

1. All of the persons or person holding interest or title to the subject property must be at least 65 years of age at the time of application. (reference section 12-48 C.G.S.)
2. The subject property must be a residential home within the Town of Coventry for which the applicant(s) are solely responsible for the payment of property tax to the Town of Coventry.
3. The applicant(s) must provide evidence that they have owned and paid property tax on a residence within the Town of Coventry for a minimum of 30 years.
4. The applicant(s) must not owe back taxes or have previously received any property tax forgiveness during their time of residency within the Town of Coventry.
5. The subject property may not be occupied by anyone other than the applicant(s). The only exception to this stipulation shall be a single (1) individual residing on the premises providing residential and/or medical care.
6. Full application would be required for the initial enrollment in **STOP** and an annual reaffirmation of information would be required each year to continue enrollment in the program.
7. Once the **STOP** is approved residential property tax would freeze at current levels however if for any reason **STOP** is not renewed the property would be placed back on the grand list at current levels of taxation and a new basis for any future application would be established at the new current rate of tax due on the property. The applicant would not

however be liable to repay any past forgiveness of taxes that may have been granted under STOP during any previous years.

8. **STOP** shall only be granted to residents for property used as a primary residence without additional income generated from use of the property. Any income generated from use of the property shall exclude the property from consideration even if the income is assigned to another individual(s) or entity. The intent of **STOP** is to protect a homestead and shall not be construed or used as a subsidy or an instrument of tax avoidance for activity that shall provide income from use of property subject to qualify as the primary residence under **STOP**.
9. **STOP** shall be granted for a single budget year and be valid for the entire budget year except in cases where the eligibility is no longer valid due to death, change of title or change of occupants at which time the eligibility for **STOP** shall cease immediately.
10. **STOP** shall not apply to any special tax assessment or emergency tax assessment due to acts of God or emergency funds required by the Town of Coventry. **STOP** shall apply to any supplemental tax that may be levied to augment a previously passed budget.
11. The Finance Director shall prepare a report annually to the Town Council prior to September 1 that includes the number of properties under **STOP** and the total cost to the Town under the last passed budget.
12. **STOP** applications and renewals for the budget year that starts in July shall be submitted between October 1 and December 31 of the previous year.
13. The income limits shall be as follows: **NONE** if **STOP** is limited to tax increases only.

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Senior Tax Option Plan

(CONCEPTIAL DRAFT ONLY)

The Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.) provide guidelines for municipally-funded elderly tax relief. Local options for elderly tax relief are not mandated by the state, however the state provides minimum criteria for applicants to qualify for the programs as well as guidelines for implementation.

Coventry as a community recognizes the importance and significance of the long term contributions our past generations have made to establish and build the quality of life we enjoy today as citizens of this great community. It was through their vision, hopes, dreams, and hard work that Coventry has become the Town we enjoy and call home today.

It is in tribute and appreciation to them that we recognize their contribution and establish a **Senior Tax Option Plan (STOP)** hereafter referred to as **STOP**. A plan for citizens above the age of 65 that have been long-term residents and currently have limited resources to continue to support increased government taxation.

STOP will allow a citizen to freeze their residential property tax at current levels, **STOP** is for citizens that qualify, based on past contribution and continued length of residence. **STOP** will provide assurance for citizens with limited funds to have some protection from government taxation increases that would erode or eliminate what income qualifying citizens do receive.

To qualify for **STOP** a person or couple must meet the following qualifications:

1. All of the persons or person holding interest or title to the subject property must be at least 65 years of age at the time of application. (reference section 12-48 C.G.S.)
2. The subject property must be a residential home within the Town of Coventry for which the applicant(s) are solely responsible for the payment of property tax to the Town of Coventry.
3. The applicant(s) must provide evidence that they have owned and paid property tax on a residence within the Town of Coventry for a minimum of 30 years.
4. The applicant(s) must not owe back taxes or have previously received any property tax forgiveness during their time of residency within the Town of Coventry.
5. The subject property may not be occupied by anyone other than the applicant(s). The only exception to this stipulation shall be a single (1) individual residing on the premises providing residential and/or medical care.
6. Full application would be required for the initial enrollment in **STOP** and an annual reaffirmation of information would be required each year to continue enrollment in the program.
7. Once the **STOP** is approved residential property tax would freeze at current levels however if for any reason **STOP** is not renewed the property would be placed back on the grand list at current levels of taxation and a new basis for any future application would be established at the new current rate of tax due on the property. The applicant would not

however be liable to repay any past forgiveness of taxes that may have been granted under STOP during any previous years.

8. **STOP** shall only be granted to residents for property used as a primary residence without additional income generated from use of the property. Any income generated from use of the property shall exclude the property from consideration even if the income is assigned to another individual(s) or entity. The intent of **STOP** is to protect a homestead and shall not be construed or used as a subsidy or an instrument of tax avoidance for activity that shall provide income from use of property subject to qualify as the primary residence under **STOP**.
9. **STOP** shall be granted for a single budget year and be valid for the entire budget year except in cases where the eligibility is no longer valid due to death, change of title or change of occupants at which time the eligibility for **STOP** shall cease immediately.
10. **STOP** shall not apply to any special tax assessment or emergency tax assessment due to acts of God or emergency funds required by the Town of Coventry. **STOP** shall apply to any supplemental tax that may be levied to augment a previously passed budget.
11. The Finance Director shall prepare a report annually to the Town Council prior to September 1 that includes the number of properties under **STOP** and the total cost to the Town under the last passed budget.
12. **STOP** applications and renewals for the budget year that starts in July shall be submitted between October 1 and December 31 of the previous year.
13. The income limits shall be as follows: **NONE** if **STOP** is limited to tax increases only.

The following information was gathered largely from an existing file in the Planning and Zoning Office entitled, "DAM - COVENTRY LAKE" and from the 1973, "STUDY OF THE DAM AT LAKE WANGUMBAUG", prepared by Griswold & Fuss, Inc., consulting engineers.

SYNOPSIS

Lake Wangumbaug is a 375+/- acre lake more commonly known as Coventry Lake. The Town of Coventry has established desirable water elevations of 91.5' as a winter level and 93.0' as a summer level for the lake. The water elevation is controlled through a Sluiceway and two-gate dam at the Southeast end of the Lake. An 1871 court decision requires that a minimum flow of 720 cubic feet per minute (c.f.m.) be kept running through the dam and down Mill Brook for not less than 13 hours a day or as needed. Presently Deknatel, a.k.a. Sutures, Inc., (formerly Cullen & Wood Co., one of the original plaintiffs - 1871) uses water from Mill Brook for fire protection and manufacturing. Deknatel has agreed to 300+/- c.f.m. as they require water 24 hours a day. The maximum flow is that when the 7" x 59" opening is unobstructed by the 10" x 61" gate (no calculated flow rate found). The responsibility of regulating between the minimum and maximum flows in order to achieve the desirable seasonal elevation is that of the Zoning Agent.

OUTLET STRUCTURE

Lake Wangumbaug receives surface runoff from a 1880+/- acre watershed and is also fed by lake bottom springs. The Lake has an average depth of 29 feet with a maximum depth of 40 feet. Lake discharge is controlled with a slide gate 10" x 61" and covers an opening 7.5" x 59". The gate is moved by a tongue and groove gear with a manual ratchet. This gear and ratchet is the primary outlet mechanism and is within a wooden gate house building.

A second steel gate is located at the South end of the Sluiceway and is movable with a power lift or payloader type vehicle. This gate can be closed to allow maintenance of the primary gate. The Sluiceway is approximately 60 feet from a trash rack to the first gate and is 6 feet wide. Both the North side and top of the Sluiceway are protected by metal grates or trash racks. The purpose of these grates is to keep large items and miscellaneous debris; such as tires, wood, rocks and anything else which can clog or interfere with the flow of water, from entering the outlet structure.

Once water flows through the Sluiceway and past the two gates, it passes through a 6' x 6' masonry arch to a junction box about 50 feet downstream from the Lake. The masonry arch extends an additional 160 feet to an open ditch which flows through a culvert under Lake Street. The Watercourse flowing from Lake Wangumbaug to the Willimantic River is known as Mill Brook.

REGULATION OF LAKE ELEVATION

The desirable water elevation of 93.0' for Summer and 91.5' for Winter, have been established by the Town. A Summer elevation of 93.0' allows a boat to go over the rock in the center of the Lake known as Elephant's Rock. This water level is also approximately 3 feet above the sand bar near Waterfront Park. A Winter elevation of 91.5' allows people to clean and maintain beaches as well as prevents ice damage to lakefront properties.

During August of 1978, a U.S.G.S. team chiseled a 3" x 3" metal square into the upper Northwest corner of the Sluiceway. This marker is at 95.0 feet of assumed elevation and is 517.27 feet above Mean Sea Level (M.S.L.). The U.S.G.S. team also determined that 93.0' of elevation is equal to 515.27' M.S.L. and 91.0' of elevation is 512.27' M.S.L. A railroad spike was also placed in CL&P utility pole #55 at an assumed elevation of 100.0' and equal to 522.28' M.S.L.

Procedure for Regulating Lake Level:

When a new person is designated as the person responsible for maintaining the desirable lake elevations he/she should make daily inspections for the first year or until he/she becomes familiar with the natural seasonal fluctuations. Once the operator is familiar with natural change of elevation the number of visits can be reduced. After each inspection, the operator shall record the

date, time, level of the Lake and any relevant comments such as weather conditions and any changes in the dam gate setting. A form such as the one attached can be used, or a similar one drafted.

Under normal weather conditions, the desirable seasonal level should be maintained as consistently and close to that level as possible. Minor changes in the gate setting will usually accomplish this. An operator must use a lot of trial and error until he/she is familiar with adjusting the gate, as any change in setting takes time to change the elevation of the Lake. Measurements and settings are counted on the side of the adjustment gear inside the gate house. The ratchets are tongue and groove for the gear and are counted as one (1) click or cog. Settings are also marked and cut in the side of the gear. The following settings have been determined:

- 1st MARK: GATE CLOSED
- 2nd MARK: GATE OPENED 1/2 INCH (10 COGS)
- 3rd MARK: GATE OPENED 1.6 INCHES (15 COGS)
- 4th MARK: GATE OPENED 2 INCHES (20 COGS)
- 5th MARK: GATE OPENED 7 INCHES [FULL (45 COGS)]

Frequent changes in the gate setting are not recommended and small rises from a storm will recede without changing the gate. A minimum gate setting of about 3/8" or 8 cogs is needed for the minimum flow as determined by the court decision. The maximum opening for normal conditions should be 2" or 20 cogs. Whenever the gate is opened more than 2", call Bill Eichner at Deknatel (742-5543) in order to prevent down stream flooding at the Deknatel dam.

During periods of heavy or extended rainfall;

If the surface elevation reaches 6" above the desired level and is rising, the gate should be opened to 3.75" (half the maximum).

If the surface elevation reaches 12" above the desired level and is rising, the gate should be opened fully (7.5 inches). Once the elevations has crested and begins to drop, the gate should be closed to one-half (3.75 inches).

Once the surface elevation drops to 6" above the desired level, the gate should be closed to 2 inches.


Once the surface elevation recedes to the desired level, normal settings should be observed again.

During periods of heavy rain and/or when the gate is opened at least one-half (3.75"), the two large culverts at the fire pond in front of C.V.F.D. should be monitored so the culvert capacity is not exceeded; as this will cause flooding onto Rte. 31.

The operator should be careful not to over-react to changes in water elevation. The elevation will vary somewhat with every storm. In addition, debris often becomes lodged around and within the outlet structure. Such debris will have an impact on the flow leaving the Lake and thus will need to be compensated for.

Routine maintenance is often required to clear debris from the trash racks of the Sluiceway. With regularity, the gate should be opened and closed the full range to insure proper mechanical condition. In addition, silt and sand may have to be cleaned from the Sluiceway entrance and gate house pit on occasion. Whenever the dam and outlet structure needs maintenance, the Superintendent of Roads should be contacted to do the necessary work. When a serious problem with the outlet structure occurs, the Town Manager and/or Town Council should be consulted.


This manual is merely to give guidelines for procedures to be followed in regulating the elevation of Lake Wangumbaug. Whenever a new person becomes the operator, there will be a substantial time period of trial and error before he/she is familiar with the changes in settings for the gate. The operator should avoid both frequent and large changes in the gate setting. In addition, a great deal of information on the Lake and outlet structure is contained in the Griswold & Fuss study of 1973, and the "DAM - COVENTRY LAKE" file in the Planning and Zoning Office. These two sources of information should be reviewed by any subsequent operator of the dam, and used for reference.

CHARGE TO THE CHS WALLS CODE COMPLIANCE BUILDING
COMMITTEE

WHEREAS: the Coventry Board of Education has raised issues regarding the code compliance for several walls at Coventry High School with wind and seismic code.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Coventry Town Council hereby establishes the CHS WALLS CODE COMPLIANCE BUILDING COMMITTEE and requests it conduct its business as follows:

1. The Committee shall have five (5) members and one (1) alternate, each one being a resident elector of Coventry. There shall be one member representing the interests of the Town Council, one member representing the interests of the Board of Education, and four citizens at large, one of which shall be the alternate. Three (3) members shall constitute a quorum. With the exception of the Board's representative, the members shall be recommended by the Steering/Liaison Committee. The Board of Education shall forward their recommended candidate to the Town Council directly. The Council shall hear the recommendations of the Steering/Liaison Committee and Board of Education and appoint the committee membership.
2. The Committee shall conduct its business with due regard to all laws and regulations governing the actions of municipal agencies, including those requirements of the Freedom of Information Act and procedures established by the State Department of Education for school facilities projects.
3. The Committee shall choose its officers annually, including a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary and establish a calendar of regular meeting dates.
4. The Committee shall implement the "educational specifications" adopted by the Coventry Board of Education for necessary code compliance work at Coventry High School including the testing, preparation of the necessary schematic drawings, cost estimates, and building specifications. The Committee shall review the work of Silva Engineering, Christopher Lau and DiBlasi Associates P.C. in preparing a solicitation for services. The project should accomplish bringing the structures into compliance with wind and earthquake loading requirements and any other pertinent code deficiency. The project should be broken into two phases – an Investigation & Design Phase and if needed a Construction Administration Phase. The Committee shall follow State guidelines for School Construction project and evaluate the potential State grant reimbursements for repair options, including timing and phasing options. The Committee shall present their recommendations to the Board of Education and the Town Council.

5. The Committee shall be able to utilize funds appropriated by the Town Council for the project to assist in the testing, development of concept plans and cost estimates. These funds may be utilized for uses such as, but not limited to, architect/engineer fees, committee clerk, testing, printing and advertising.
6. The Committee shall procure the services of an architectural/engineering firm utilizing the required process established by the State Department of Education to assure qualification for grant in aid.
7. Upon acceptance of the Committee's recommendation, with or without modifications by the Board of Education and the Town Council, and after the Town Council calls a Town Meeting on a proposed project, the Committee shall present its report to public forums, including a Special Town Meeting, to educate the public prior to the referendum (if required).
8. If the proposal receives a favorable vote by the Town Meeting/Referendum, the Committee shall enter the construction phase. In this phase, the Committee shall be responsible for: a) the expenditure of any funds provided by the Town; b) for putting out to bid and monitoring any construction plan that may be approved by the voters; c) assuring timely submittal of requests for grant reimbursements/ payments from the State of Connecticut; d) hiring a Clerk of the Works and Special Inspector, if required, to assure quality construction practices and to keep a log of construction.
