


COVENTRY HUD HOUSING REHABILITATION/FAIR HOUSING COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES
ORCHARD HILL ESTATES
January 4, 2016 7:00PM

The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM.

Appoint a new Chairman: Al Bradley nominated Marjorie Roach. Dorothy Grady seconded the nomination. All in favor none opposed.

Audience of Citizens: None

Accept Minutes: Al Bradley made the motion to accept minutes of October 7, 2013; April 7, 2014, and October 5, 2015. Dorothy Grady seconded the motion. Unanimously approved.

Old Business: None.

New Business: Al Bradley made the statement that both the Coventry Housing Rehabilitation Committee and the Fair Housing Committee will now be one Committee named the Coventry HUD Housing Rehabilitation/Fair Housing Committee.

Community Consulting's Report. The current Housing Rehab Grant is approximately 88% expended with eight projects from Columbia and eight projects from Coventry. Presently the Program has 15 applications from Coventry and 3 applications from Columbia. There are also six households in Coventry that have returned postcards expressing interest in the Program. John Elsesser, Coventry Town Manager, has expressed interest in applying for additional housing rehab funding through the CT Department of Housing. Small Cities Housing Rehab Grant Applications are due on April 11, 2016. The town has not approached the Town of Columbia to see if they are interested in submitting a multijurisdictional grant application. Columbia's Town Administrator will be contacted next week.
