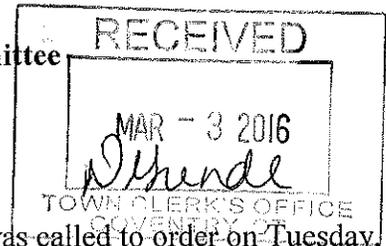


Coventry Lake Advisory & Monitoring Committee

Regular Meeting Minutes

A regular meeting of the Coventry Lake Advisory & Monitoring Committee was called to order on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at 7:04 p.m. in the Town Hall Conference Room B by Chair Debby Zeppa. Trott, and Dr. Kortmann regarding Hydrilla. DEEP is planning a forum in Coventry about Hydrilla. Greg Bugbee is also willing to have a workshop on Hydrilla identification. Linda is preparing a short article for the newsletter.

Flyboards – Senate Bill 136 is being considered by the legislature regarding flyboards. Distances from shore and other vessels were added to the current bill from last year.

Committee priorities for 2016 – Ideas for July awareness month were discussed.

Correspondence/communications – D. Zeppa notified the committee about the CT Federation of Lakes annual meeting April 9, 2016.
