


**Coventry Lake Advisory & Monitoring Committee**  
**Tuesday, April 5, 2016**  
**Regular Meeting Minutes**  
**Town Hall Building**



**Call to Order** – A regular meeting of the Coventry Lake Advisory & Monitoring Committee was called to order on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 at 7:06 p.m. in the Town Hall Conference Room B by Chair Debby Zeppa. Other members present were Charlie Brown, Jr., Jack Clausen, Linda Comeau, and new member Scott Gallo. Absent were Leslie Shor and Jerry Zak.

**Secretary's Report** – Linda Comeau moved to accept the minutes of the March 1, 2016 meeting. The motion was seconded by Jack Clausen and the minutes were approved.

**New Business** – The Committee's new member, Scott Gallo, introduced himself and discussed his background, and present Committee members did the same.

**Old Business** –

Lake Management Plan – D. Zeppa has submitted the management plan to be uploaded to web site, which should be done soon. The proposed date of May 17<sup>th</sup> for the management plan workshop has been changed to May 18<sup>th</sup> at Patriot's Park. Members discussed the organization for the workshop, and advertising options.

Hydrilla – D. Zeppa reported on the meeting with CT DEEP on March 8<sup>th</sup>. The State will provide funding for two invasive plant surveys on the Lake in June and August to monitor for any possible spread of Hydrilla, and will provide funding for the treatment of the known Hydrilla colony in July.

Flyboards – Senate Bill 136, regarding flyboards, is still pending in the legislature.

Committee priorities for 2016 – It was suggested to try to have Greg Bugbee conduct his workshop on Hydrilla/Invasive plants in July as part of Lake Awareness Month.

**Correspondence/Communications** – D. Zeppa and C. Brown will be attending the CT Federation of Lakes annual meeting on April 9, 2016.
