For your convenience Bay State Textile has provided The Town of Coventry a collection trailer which is located at our transfer station and a small collection box located at 100 Olsen Farm Road.

Bay State Textile will also be paying the Town of Coventry a rebate for every ton collected which will go into the COVRRRA fund to offset expenses and help keep your bills stable.

Did you know? ... 85% of all unwanted textiles end up in our solid waste stream. This makes up on average 5% of our solid waste. Remember that every ton tossed costs over \$60.00

All of the following items are acceptable and can be donated in any condition as long as they're clean and dry. Must be in bags.

draperies, dresses, flip
flops, Halloween
costumes, hats, jackets,
jeans, jerseys
(sports), napkins (cloth),
pajamas, pants, pet beds,
pet clothing, pillows, pillow
cases, purses, scarves,
sheets, shirts, shoes,
shorts, skirts, slippers, socks, stuffed animals, suits, sweaters,
sweatpants, sweatshirts, table liners, ties, towels, t-shirts,
