Creaser Park Disc Golf Course General Guidelines

- The play area is open from dawn to dusk.
- Please read the rules and follow them closely.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times.
- There are signs on each hole to indicate where the basket is.
- Please do not damage the natural habitat, woods, animals, or disc golf equipment.
- When you are using the course, you are doing so at your own risk.
- Watch for flying discs from other players and watch for other people before you throw your disc.
- Be prepared for a hike in the woods while playing disc golf. This could include (but may not be limited to) water, sunscreen, insect repellent, closed toed protective shoes, proper clothing, and your own discs.
- In order to keep our park clean, we ask that you carry out anything that you bring in with you, including all garbage and personal items.

Disc Golf Course Rules

- 1. Pedestrians have the right of way.
- 2. The official teeing surface is the rubber mat only.
- 3. Please allow others to pass through if their pace-of-play is faster and/or if you are jumping in to play a shorter "loop".
- 4. Mandatory Instructions (MANDOS) are marked with an M and an arrow showing which direction you must follow. If you pass on the wrong side of the Mando, go to Mando drop zone and add 1 stroke penalty.
- 5. Out of Bounds (OB) is marked with bricks or tall grass, or water. All discs that are totally out of bounds is out of bounds OB.
- 6. Drop Zones: If your disc is out of bounds, 1 stroke penalty and play from holes' designated drop zone.
- 7. Please do not throw from tall grass areas this is a sensitive wildlife habitat and should not be disturbed.

COVID-19 Safety Rules:

- Stay home if you are experiencing symptoms.
- Wash your hands with soap & water or use hand sanitizer for 20 seconds before and after activities.
- Wear a face covering when 6-ft social distancing is not possible & when moving about the parks.
- Groups are limited to no more than 5 people, unless they are immediate family.
