Based on our review of the comments from Todd Penny's email and his request of a mitigation plan for the access rainwater from the plot and the house as well as a barrier to separate the yard from the wetlands line. I Kapelmooney Mahapot and with the help of Richard Snarski from NEES and consulting services we Propose to install a shrub and low lying plants which consist of "Winter Red Berries, Low lying Blue berry bushes and Dogwood shrubs " these plants are common to the area. I propose to plant them in 2 rows in the areas along the wetland lines based on the plot plan from Datum Engineering. We can plant them behind the house and along the yard to the septic areas. I also propose to add a weed barrier and mulch under the plats to create a buffer to filter out the natural flow of rainwater from the yard prior to it getting into the wetland areas when it rains. We will maintain the plants, mulch and do our best to preserve the wetlands area to the best of our ability.
