## SOUTH STREET RECONSTRUCTION AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS

### SCENIC ROAD ALTERATIONS

The Town is has received a LOTCIP grant from the State of CT in order to reconstruct the section of South Street from the Daly Road/South Street roundabout to just north of the Holy Grove at the Nathan Hale Homestead.

This section of road is a designated scenic road and is subject to the requirements of the Scenic Road Ordinance, specifically Section 86-146 (d) and Section 86-147 (1 – 10 criteria). Please refer to the attached copies.

Pursuant to Section 86-146 (d), the Commission must conduct a public hearing to review the improvements being proposed and determine that they are necessary to protect and promote public safety. Also, the Commission must evaluate what alternatives were considered with the subject project.

Pursuant to Section 86-147 (1-10), any alterations and improvements shall be carried out in a manner to preserve to the highest degree possible, the scenic characteristics of South Street. Please refer to the attached copy which provides details on the 1-10 criteria.

The consultant for the Town and Town Engineer will be providing a Powerpoint presentation during the meeting to describe the overall project and how it complies with the Scenic Road Ordinance.
