Valid at Patriots Park and Liscike Beach

VISITOR/NON-RESIDENTS - PATRIOTS PARK ONLY

Passes available at the Patriots Park Gate upon entering during the season.

- Weekends: (Saturdays & Sundays) 9:00 am - 7:00 pm
 - \$30 Per Car weekends & holidays
 - *State sales tax included
- STARTING JUNE 21: Weekdays: (Mondays - Fridays) 11:45 am - 7:00 pm
 - \$15 Per Car

Daily Organized Group rates : Vans: \$35 per vehicle Busses \$75 per vehicle - Please arrange in advance with office. May require additional charge for lifeguards.

RESIDENT PARKING PERMITS - LISICKE BEACH & PATRIOTS PARK

Liscike Beach open weekends & holidays May 29 - Aug.22 11am - 7pm
Patriots Park B each open weekdays June 21 - Aug 22 11:45am - 7 pm daily
Open weekends & holidays May 29 - Aug 22 9am - 7pm

- **Seasonal Beach Parking Sticker** \$25 for 1st vehicle, \$12 for each additional vehicle
*State sales tax included
- **Senior Citizens** shall receive a free hanging-parking pass for access to Patriots Park and Liscike Beach parking lots, at no charge for weekdays (M-F ONLY).

****This parking pass is not acceptable at Patriots Park or Liscike Beach on weekends and is NOT required for access to the Senior Center . ****
- **Caregivers/ Nannies/Grandparents** may purchase a beach-parking sticker regardless of their residency providing proof of their role as caregiver by the resident.
- **A One-Day Guest Parking Pass** is available for those residents who do not want to buy a season beach-parking sticker for \$5 per day. If a resident decides to purchase a sticker, what they have paid in daily passes is credited toward the seasonal parking sticker.

NOTE: Financial aid is available for eligible households. Military discounts available for all active duty military and their household. Please inquire at Recreation Department for application forms.

Note: A Resident Beach parking pass is **not** required to access the Transfer Station. A Valid drivers' license will suffice.

For the safety of our gate attendants, please place BEACH PARKING PASSES on the PASSENGER'S SIDE, LOWER CORNER OF THE WINDSHIELD. Please remove all outdated stickers from the windshield to make it easier for gate attendant to check.

Beach Rules & Regulations - the following strictly prohibited:

- Swimming when lifeguard is off duty
 - Fishing or boat launching from the shore
 - Full Face Swim Masks, tubes or floats
 - Nudity
 - Open fires
 - Alcohol
 - Animals, except service animals
 - Rough play
 - Loud radios
 - Swimming outside marked swim area
 - Glass bottles
 - Feeding the wildlife
- Park only in designated parking areas - please stay off the grass.
 - Bathing suits required, no cut-offs or street clothes in the water.
 - All infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers.
 - Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult
 - "What you carry in, you must carry out"

RESIDENT PARKING PERMIT INFORMATION : Resident Parking Permits available at the Parks & Recreation Office. The Parks & Recreation Office is located at the Coventry Town Hall, 1712 Main Street, Coventry.

Office Hours for Permit sales are:

Monday - Wednesday: 8:30am - 4pm; Thursday: 8:30am - 6pm; and Friday: 8:30am - 12:30pm

THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE:

1. **Completed application**
2. **A copy of the current vehicle registration** for each vehicle for which a Permit is required. A copy of the tax bill is required with leased vehicle. If your vehicle is registered to a business, documentation linking you to the business is required. If you purchase a new vehicle and need a new Permit (even if you transfer the license plates to the new car), you will need to submit a copy of your vehicle registration.
3. **All vehicles must be registered to the same address.**
4. **If you are a renter**, a Coventry Real Estate Tax Bill, Deed or Purchase and Sales Agreement (for Coventry visitors - a Lease or Rental Agreement for your Coventry vacation location is required), or a utility, cable TV or credit card bill.
5. **Cash, check or money order** made payable to the "Town of Coventry" in the total amount due. Please do not mail cash. Credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, and Discover) are accepted in person and on-line.
6. If purchasing by mail, also include a **Self-addressed, stamped envelope** .

Incomplete applications received by mail are held at the Parks & Recreation Office for completion or pickup. **If you list your email address and there is an issue with your**

application, we will notify you via email. Resident Parking Permits will be mailed beginning June 1.
