



INLAND WETLANDS PERMIT TO CONDUCT REGULATED ACTIVITIES

PERMIT NUMBER: #21- W

PERMIT HOLDER/APPLICANT: Town of Coventry – Department of Public Works

ACTIVITY PERMITTED: Projects with a maximum of 300sqft of direct disturbance to install/maintain storm outfalls and emergency repairs.

REASON FOR DECISION: The applicant has demonstrated the following:

- Implementation of erosion and sedimentation controls measures to protect the regulated areas.
- Implementation of best management practices throughout all stages of construction.

PERMIT CONDITIONS:

- Coordinate a site visit with the Town Wetland Agent prior to the start of work to review the proposed activities and construction sequencing (when possible).
- Submit documentation of the proposed activity (i.e. sketch, site plan, photos, engineering detail)
- Notify the Town Wetland Agent prior to the start of construction (when possible).
- Additional erosion & sedimentation controls and conditions may be required as site conditions/weather warrant by the Wetlands staff.

No person shall conduct any regulated activity within an inland wetland or watercourse which requires zoning or subdivision approval without first having obtained a valid certificate of zoning or subdivision approval, special permit, special exception, variance, or other documentation establishing that the proposal complies with the zoning or subdivision requirements adopted by the municipality pursuant to Chapters 124 to 126 of the Connecticut General Statutes inclusive; or any special act, including permits as required under Federal Army Corps of Engineers and the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection.
